Table 1 shows that in English and Mathematics student attainment and progress is significantly above the national average. In addition, attainment and progress in Ebac subjects (Science, History, Geography, French and Spanish) is significantly above the national average.

Table 2 shows that the number of entries for traditional GCSE subjects is significantly above the national average. The number of entries for non-GCSE subjects is significantly below the national average; the overwhelming majority of students follow a fully academic pathway.

Table 3 shows the attainment levels of 2014 Year 11 students when entering Cardinal Wiseman in Year 7.
