



Enquiries About Results (EAR) – Summer 2017

If you are disappointed in your results you **must talk to your teacher or head of department** in the first instance. They will help you review the grade boundaries. This tells you how far away you are from the next grade. If you are more than 4 or 5 points away from the next grade, a review is unlikely to have an impact for you. Last year, most changes were no more than 1-3 marks. Approximately 40% of the reviews requested resulted in a grade change.

The grade boundaries are published by each exam board on results day. The following are page links to where they should be located.

Once you have established that you are close to the next higher grade boundary, you can consider requesting a remark. You should then consider which unit(s) to get remarked. A conversation with your teacher or head of department is strongly advised prior to making a decision.

Service	Cost ⁽¹⁾	Description
Service 1 Clerical check Available up to Friday 15th September 2017	£14	Check that all marks are included in total and all questions marked.
Service 2 Review of Marking Available up to Friday 15th September 2017	£43	A second examiner will review the paper again to identify genuine marking errors or unreasonable marking. This includes a clerical check. All marks are counted.
Service 2P Priority Review of Marking (AS/A Level) Available up to Tuesday 22nd August 2017	£51	A quicker service only available to students who have a university place or other higher education institution offer pending ⁽²⁾
Access to Scripts (Copy) Available up to Monday 25th September 2017	£13	This is a photocopy of the marked exam paper that you can use to review work for future information.
