### Important reminders for induction day

- 1. Students must be in primary school uniform
- 2. Students must bring in a (nut free) packed lunch and water bottle
- 3. If your child requires emergency medication, they will need to attend the medical room before they go anywhere else on site. Medical will be open from 8.15. They MUST have their emergency medication with them.

This includes Epipens, asthma pumps and any other medication . They can either leave these in medical or keep their box on them

Attendance

- Average attendance 2017/18 = 96.3%
- An attendance rate of 92% or below is classified as a cause for concern
- Where possible make all appointments outside of school hours
- Leave of Absence <u>will not</u> be authorised for family holidays or when it is requested just before or after a school break



### Absence

- If your child is absent, please notify the school no later than 8.30 a.m.
  - No contact = text/email after 10.30a.m.
  - $-2^{nd}$  day=  $2^{nd}$  text/email
  - $-3^{rd}$  day = phone call
- Warning letter once your child's attendance drops below 95%
- Below 90% Persistent Absentee (DfE)



### **Punctuality**

- If your child arrives late then they will have a LATE stamp in their diary for that day
- 2 lates per week-1 hour dentation after school on Friday
- 6 lates in a half term will result in a Saturday detention
- 10 lates 40 minute detention each subsequent day they are late

## Uniform

- No jewellery may be worn, except for watches & stud earrings (girls only)
- All jewellery must be removed for PE lessons including ear piercings
- Coats *must be long enough to cover the blazer;* plain black or navy – no motives or stripes
- Jumpers must be worn in Autumn and Winter terms

### **Tutor Groups**

- There are 12 tutor groups in Year 7
- Divided into half year groups
- Tutor groups decided after primary school visits and Student Induction Day
- Tutor group competitions throughout the year
- Mass and Assembly



## **Teaching Groups**

- All pupils are taught in mixed ability groups for the following subjects: **Art, Drama, Music, PE, DT, IT** and **PSHE** (Personal, Social and Health Education)
- All pupils are taught in set groups for the following subjects: English, Maths, Science, RE, Languages, History and Geography
- Pupils are placed in broad ability sets based on their KS2 scores for English, Maths and Science
- Reorganisation of the sets. This is based on a combination of Teacher Assessment during the Autumn term, KS2 scores and CATs scores





### **ParentPay**

- Secure online income collection and management service which allows you to make payments to school using your debit/credit cards or in cash using the ParentPay top-up card at local PayPoint outlets.

### **How Does It Work?**

- You have a secure online account accessible 24/7
- We post items for payment to your account
- You then choose how to pay
- ParentPay keeps a record of all payments you make
- You have greater control of your account using automated email/SMS alerts

You will be sent a Parentpay card which you can top up, with cash or debit cards, at local Paypoint outlets



## **Data Protection and GDPR**

- All data in our electronic systems is password protected with access only to those necessary. Paper copies are also treated with equal care.
- We are expected to keep your child's data until they are 25 (or 35 for those with special educational needs).
- It is important that we always have up to date medical and contact information so in September will be enrolling you in "SIMS parent" which will allow you to view and update such details securely.
