Entry Requirements for The Cardinal Wiseman Sixth Form

General Entry Requirements

Minimum 5 x Level 9 to 4 GCSE passes including a grade 4 in English Language.

Accelerated pathway A Levels

Specific: 5 x Level 9 to 7 GCSE passes in individual subjects

Academic pathway A Levels

Specific: 6 x Level 9 to 4 GCSE passes in individual subjects including English Language

Technical pathway BTEC/A Level

Specific: Minimum 4 x Level 9 to 4 GCSE passes including English Language

For all A Level courses there are additional subject specific entry requirements (see 'Entry Requirements' insert and the Course Guide).

In the case of over-subscription the following admissions critieria will apply:

- 1. Catholic Looked After Children who meet the Entry Requirements.
- 2. Students who are on roll at Cardinal Wiseman Catholic School at the end of the academic year immediately preceding the proposed date of entry into the Sixth Form who meet the Entry Requirements.
- 3. Students from schools other than the Cardinal Wiseman Catholic School who meet the Entry Requirements. Priority will be given to Catholic applicants whose application is supported by a baptismal certificate.

A Levels and BTEC Level 3 Diplomas

- If you are following the Accelerated or Academic Pathway – you need to choose 3 A Level subjects. (In some cases, students will be allowed to study 4 A Levels, in agreement with the 6F team and dependent on GCSE grades).
- If you are following the technical pathway – you need to choose one BTEC course (tick all relevant boxes in the blocks).
 - BTEC Media is an Extended Diploma (equivalent to 3 x A levels)
 - BTEC Business is a Diploma (equivalent to 2 x A levels). You
- have to pick 1 A level or the BTEC Travel and Tourism (equivalent to 1 x A level).
- BTEC Travel and Tourism is an Extended Certificate. You have to pick BTEC Business or 2 x additional A levels.

All subject choices must be in different blocks.

Take into consideration what you want to do at university and whether the subjects you choose will help you gain entry.
