Entry Requirements

6 x Level 9 to 4 GCSE passes including a 4 in English Language and a grade 6 in Maths as well as a 6 in Biology or 6/6 in Combined Science.

Biology is the study of the living world. It provides the opportunity to learn and understand areas such as genetic engineering, DNA fingerprinting and advances in the medical world which are making a real impact on our lives. Throughout both Year 12 and Year 13 students are required to sit examinations which test their biological knowledge as well as complete practical examinations.
