

Exam Information - Year 13

AS Level and A Level public exams will start from Monday 15th May. The next few weeks will be crucial; good routines, healthy eating and sleeping habits will ensure that students are ready for what can be a stressful period ahead.

Last half term the 6F team led many sessions on effective revision techniques and I have attached documents that were sent home that will be a useful reminder of using revision schedules and where to find subject resources. It is really important that students have a quiet place to work, free from distractions and without their phone so that they can concentrate fully on their learning. They should be spending at least 3 hours after school on revision (this should not be in one long session - but broken up into smaller bite size chunks).

The 6F study area is available for all students before and after school and many students are already using this silent, supervised facility to great effect. It is really encouraging to see so many Y13 students working really hard in their study periods during the day - completely focused and motivated to succeed. **The study area will be open throughout the exam period.**

Many staff members are offering intervention and revision sessions (timetable attached) as well meeting with students individually to support them.
