

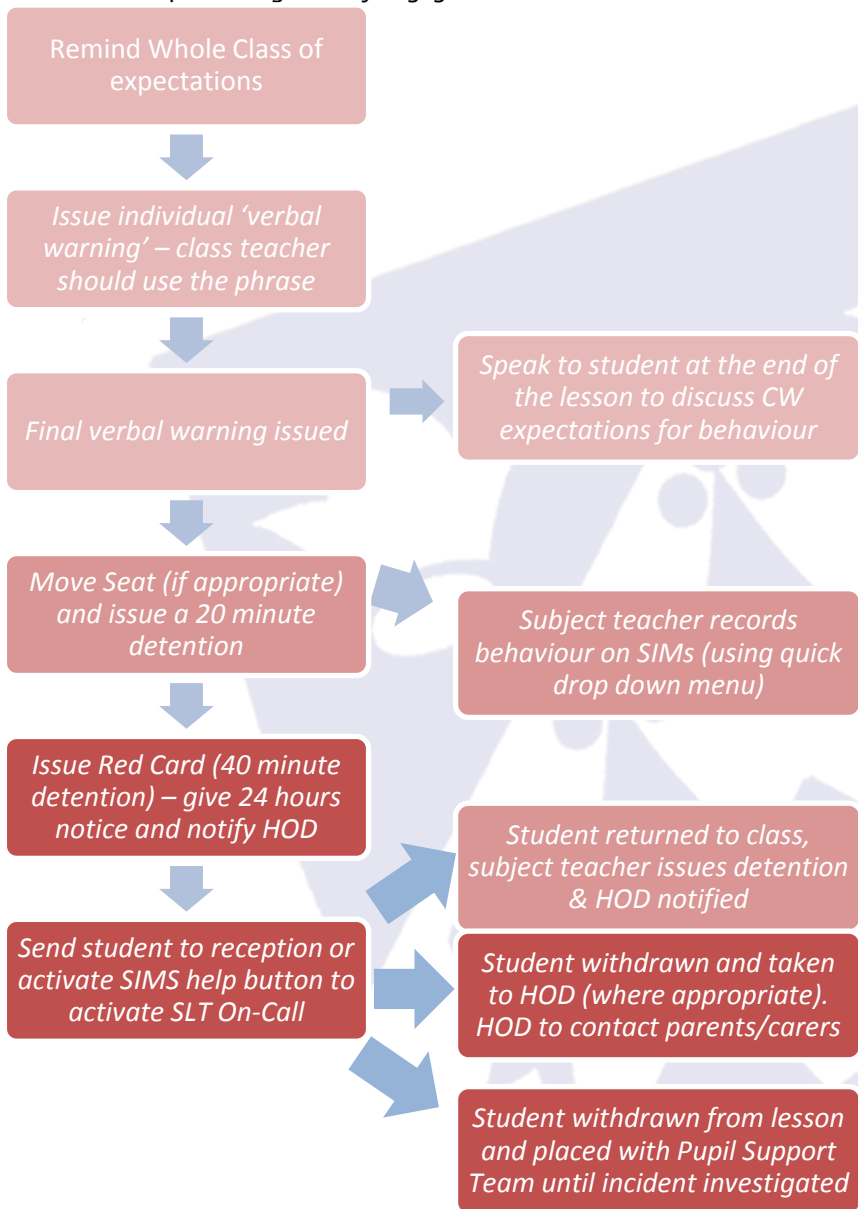

Classroom consequences for Non-Productive behaviour

All staff should follow this procedure when addressing behavioural concerns and promoting actively engaged behaviour.





Choose your Behaviour

Tier 4 Achievement

- Consistent behaviour for learning over time
- Exceptional Academic Performance
- Exceptional performance in the arts or sport

Tier 3 Achievement – 5 Achievement Points

- Tutor Achievement Award
- High Effort Grades (8 at KS3 – 6 at KS4)

Tier 2 Achievement – 2 Achievement Points

- Excellent attendance to extra-curricular clubs
- Supporting school events
- 100% attendance in a term
- 100% punctuality in a term

Tier 1 Achievement – 1 Achievement Point

- Excellent class or homework
- Excellent effort in class
- Improved work or attitude to work
- Excellent Manners/respect to staff and peers
- Positive contribution to the community or class
- Excellent contribution to group work
- Contribution to tutor group
- Supporting Charity events



Choose your Behaviour

Tier 1 Behaviour

- Lack of effort (classwork/homework)
- Minor disruption (talking, out of seat, distracting others)
- Failure to contribute to group work
- Lack of equipment
- Eating/drinking in lessons
- Late for lessons

Tier 2 Behaviour

- Persistent lack of effort (classwork/homework) after a “20-Minute” detention has been issued
- Language not deemed appropriate to the learning environment (swearing, hurtful comments)
- Persistent poor behaviour after a “20-Minute” detention has been issued
- Persistently failing to bring correct equipment
- Failure to act on teachers’ instructions
- Failure to attend 20 minute detention
- Unacceptable use of technologies & the internet (minor infringements)
- Persistent lateness during a week
- Using a mobile phone (followed by confiscation)
- Incorrect Uniform

Tier 3 Behaviour

- Open defiance/repeatedly failing to act on teachers instructions
- Inappropriate language towards a teacher
- Physical aggression
- Persistently wearing incorrect uniform
- Inappropriate physical contact (physical, sexual)
- Bullying (Verbal, Physical, Cyber, indirect)
- Language which is deemed threatening or of a racist nature
- Vandalism or wilful acts of damage to school property
- Persistent lateness over time
- Littering/throwing water/ possession of chewing gum
- Being out of bounds/in a building without permission
- Persistent failure to attend tier 2 sanctions

Tier 4 Behaviour

- Persistently breaking the code of conduct (despite tier 3 sanctions & interventions)

Tier 5 Behaviour

- Involvement with weapons (any items made or adapted, for causing or intending to cause injury)
- Bringing into school handling, using, dealing or concealing of drugs
- Extreme acts of violence
- Persistent lack of cooperation despite tier 4 sanctions & interventions



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Affect your Outcomes

Tier 1 Achievement – Responsibility of all staff

- Post cards home
- Achievement Points
- Phone Call home
- Verbal Praise
- Comment based marking

Tier 2 Achievements - Responsibility of Year Teams

- Head of Year Certificate
- Headteacher Certificate
- Work displayed

Tier 3 Achievement – Responsibility of Year Teams

- Name displayed on plasma screen (weekly)
- Name in the school newsletter/website
- Celebration assembly (each term)
- Effort Grade certificates (each term)
- Gold Achievement Medal
- Curriculum Certificates
- Attendance Draw (each term)

Tier 4 Achievement – Responsibility of SLT

- Celebration of Success evening
- Rewards Vouchers
- Prom Pass (Year 11 only)



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Affect your Outcomes

Tier 1 Sanctions – Responsibility of all staff

- Verbal warning
- Move seats
- 20 minute Detention (with teacher) and behaviour point recorded

Tier 2 Behaviour - All staff (Notify HOD)

- 40 minute (Red Card) detention & behaviour point recorded
- 1 hour late detention (24 hours' notice required)
- Communication with parent/guardian (FROG, Planner or phonecall)
- Subject report

Tier 3 Behaviour - Year Teams & SLT

- Removal of Prom Pass (Year 11 only)
- Internal Exclusion
- Saturday Detention
- Year Teams Report
- SLT Report
- Community Service
- Fixed Term Exclusion

Tier 4 Behaviour - SLT & Headteacher

- Pastoral Support Plan
- Managed Move
- Alternative Provision

Tier 5 - Headteacher

- Permanent exclusion is a last resort for Cardinal Wiseman and all steps are taken to avoid this. However, involvement with drugs (bringing into school, handling, using, dealing or concealing), offensive weapons (any items made or adapted, for causing or intending to cause injury), extreme acts of violence and persistent lack of co-operation **will** result in permanent exclusion from the school.
