I am writing to inform you of the Revision and Exam Preparation Programme put in place in the run up to the final exams in May and June in order to support the students' achievement in all of their subjects.

There are a number of revision and support classes currently running for the year 11 students. After the February half term this will be extended and a full range of classes will be in place during lunchtime and after school. The framework for the Revision Timetable is below:

Students are selected to attend these classes if they need support in the particular topic being studied or need to complete work for their coursework. The classes they attend may change each week but, as a general rule, **year 11 students should expect to remain at school until 4.20 pm each day**. The classes are compulsory and we would be very grateful if you would support us in ensuring your son or daughter attends these sessions. The school will also provide the students with a drink and a snack to keep their energy levels up at the end of the school day. You will also receive regular text messages regarding the revision classes.

The students are also being provided with a green booklet which details the Exam timetable, Revision timetable and resources for each subject to help them prepare for the exams, as well as a red booklet which is a study and revision guide; parents and carers have found both of these a useful tool to support their child with their revision.

Finally, the year 11 students will be starting their Study Leave on Monday May 12<sup>th</sup> which is when they will be sitting their first exam – we will be contacting you with further information on this at a later date.
