

Boys Hairstyles



The school expects children to have a conservative hairstyle which matches the expectations of our school uniform policy. A grade 2 is the shortest cut the school permits; this applies to the back and sides of the student's hair as well as the top.

The school does not permit student's to have lines or extreme hairstyles; this would include (but not exclusive to) the following hairstyles:



Too short and a tram line



Too long on the top and too short on the sides



Not graduated in



Below a grade 2 on the back & sides



Braided hair must be braided at the sides



Twists are not suitable



Undercut is not suitable

As a general rule of thumb hair must be cut evenly on both sides of the head and the top of the hair should blend in with the back and sides. Cane rolls are acceptable if applied to the whole head (not just the top and shaved at the sides).
