- Block release by weeks or months
- Your place of education and qualification is decided by the employer

Application Process

- > You are applying for a job directly to the employer
- > Check the start date, it should be after the end of exams
- > You can apply for as many apprenticeships as you like
- > On-line application
- On-line testing (numerical, situational judgement, critical thinking,)
- > On-line or telephone interview
- > Assessment day (tasks, presentations, group exercises, in person interview)

How do you prepare?

- Research the company, their own website, mission statement, articles about them, their latest projects, achievements, awards,
- Make your application relevant to that employer by matching it to their job description
- Use assessmentday.com to practice the tests and interview questions

Help at school

- At The Cardinal Wiseman School we run weekly Enrichment Twilight Sessions every Monday of the term from September till Easter
- Guest speakers range from experts from different industries, universities and government organisations
- All students are welcome to attend
