- Applications for September 2026 start will open in February/March 2026
- Tuition fees are currently up to £9,250 per year and are expected to increase to £9,535 for the 2025/26 academic year; a £285 increase
- Tuition fees will be paid directly to university or college
- Maintenance Loan paid to student in 3 instalments throughout the year (beginning of each semester), and will depend on the family income

WHO CAN GET TUITION FEE AND MAINTENANCE LOAN (FULL SUPPORT)

UK or Irish Nationals:

- Living in the UK for 3 consecutive years before starting the course
- England is the permanent home

• EU Nationals:

Settled status granted under the EU Settlement Scheme

Other Nationals:

• Settled status granted for other reasons (indefinite leave to remain, refugee status)

WHO CAN GET TUITION FEES ONLY

- You are an EU national
- You have been living in the UK for the past three years
- You have pre-settled status under the EU Settlement Scheme
