# WHO CAN GET TUITION FEE AND MAINTENANCE LOAN (FULL SUPPORT)

- For UK or Irish nationals
  - You have been living in the UK for 3 years before starting your course
  - England is your permanent home
- For EU nationals
  - You must have a full settled status under the EU Settlement Scheme
- For other nationals
  - You are granted settled status for other reasons (indefinite leave to remain, refugee status)

#### WHO CAN GET TUITION FEES ONLY

- You are an EU national or a family member of an EU national
- You have been living in the UK for the past three years
- You have pre-settled status under the EU Settlement Scheme
