



Information for Families of New Year 7 Student

Dear Parent/Carer,

I am writing to welcome you and your family to the Wiseman Community. We hope that your child is looking forward to starting their learning journey with us. I would like to outline the arrangements for the start of the Autumn term.

Year 7 – Arrangements for first day Monday 5th September:

8.50 am	Students meet Mr. Coyle (Head teacher) and Senior Staff in the Hall
9.15 am	Introduction to Tutor and Tutor Group
9.30 am to 11.20 am	Induction into School routines and timetable
11.20am to 11.35am	Break
11.35 am to 12.35 pm	Lessons
12.35 pm to 1.20 pm	Lunch
1.20 pm to 2.20 pm	Lessons
2.20 pm to 3.20 pm	Welcome Mass in Our Lady of Visitation Church (families welcome to attend)

Lunch: Children with money on their account will be able to purchase hot food from the school canteen using the cashless register system. Those bringing a packed lunch to school can eat in the Dining Hall with the other children, with the significant advantage of not having to queue.

Uniform: Please read the uniform list carefully as incorrect uniform cannot be worn by the students.

Equipment: Students should be fully equipped for each lesson with pens (blue, black, red & green), pencils, ruler, compass, rubber and appropriate exercise/text books (the latter are supplied by the school). All students must have a personal reading book with them. Other items that should be purchased before/in September are:

Mathematics	Protractor, Ruler, Compasses & Calculator - for example Casio FX-83ES or similar (WH Smith and all good stationers)
Design Technology	Work Apron (listed school suppliers)
PE	All items of PE kit can be purchased from the School Uniform Suppliers – PMG and Juniper
For all subjects	Clear sticky backed plastic will need to be purchased to cover all exercise books (WHSmith and all good stationers)

School Lockers: Please provide a small padlock to secure the locker assigned to your child.
