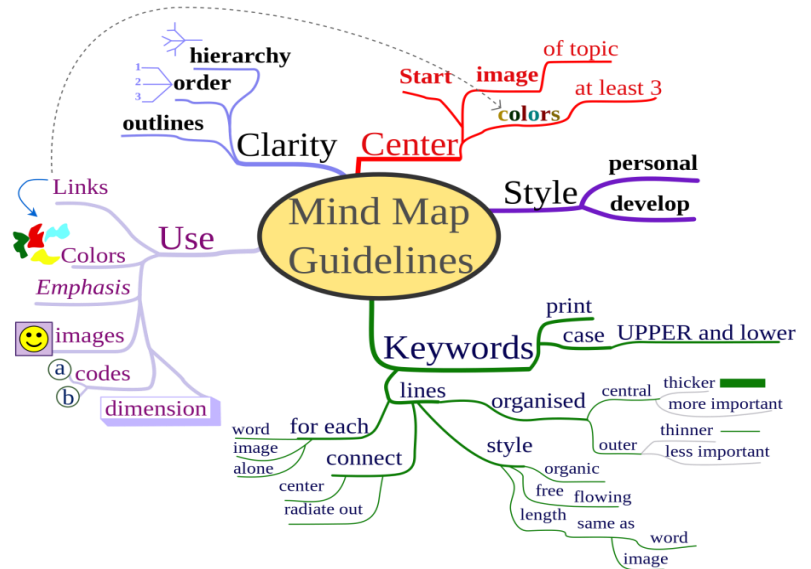
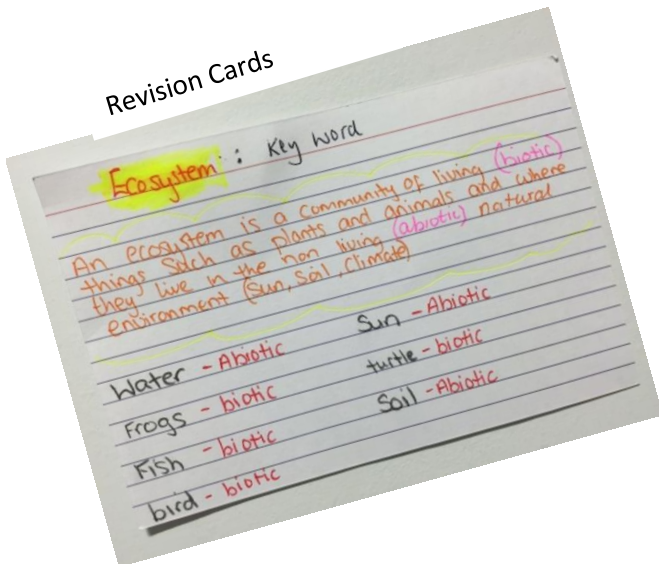


Independent and Home Learning Guide

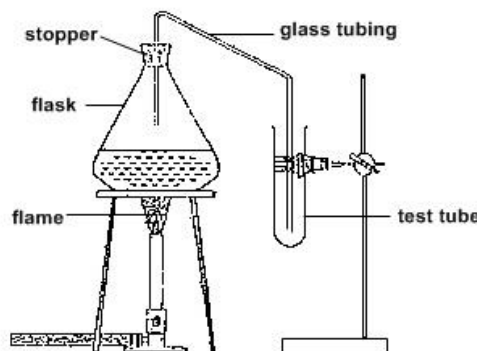


- Practise spelling of key words across all subject areas (found at the back of student planners)
- Reading a newspaper or novel or read a news website and summarise this in one paragraph
- Watch BBC Newsround or BBC documentaries which link to your school learning and make notes on key points
- Revision activities: Use of Mind Maps (see below), Revision Cards or Mini whiteboards (in student planner)



- Practise key skills: Reading local and world Maps (Geography) Maths formulas and facts (in student planners), The Periodic Table (Science - in student planners), key words in French/Spanish (in student planners)
- Make a list of key terms and definitions in the back of your exercise books that relate to specific topics learnt in lessons (e.g. Science: Cells – all key words associated to this topic)
- Annotating and labelling diagrams/photos (Geography, Science, Art, MFL, PE)
