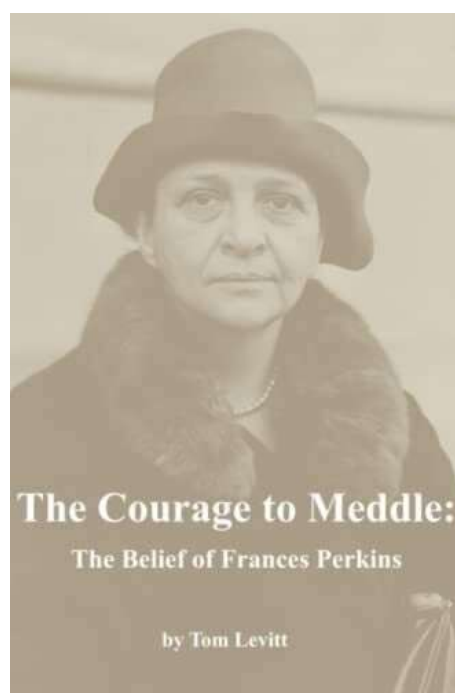


Wiseman Career Lecture 2



In our second Wiseman Career Lecture on 18th September, we hosted Mr Tom Levitt, ex- Labour Party MP and an inspirational public speaker. Mr Levitt talked about his career as a science teacher, politician and an author of many books. His many years of being an MP took him on many travels around the world and he told us many stories about meeting important people at the time, such as Mikhail Gorbachev and Lech Walesa, and all the incredible conversations he had with them. As a consultant on the Responsible Business, which includes inclusive economy, climate change and modern slavery and also co-founder of the anti-poverty social enterprise 'Fair for You' Mr Levitt talked to students about their responsibility towards society and the planet. He also mentioned books he has published as Sector 4 Focus on responsible and sustainable business. His favourite book he ever worked on was 'The Courage to Meddle' a biography of Frances Perkins, an amazing American workers-rights activist and the United States Secretary of Labour from 1933-1945 and a first woman to serve in the presidential cabinet. One of our students was even lucky to get a copy of the book from Mr Levitt.
