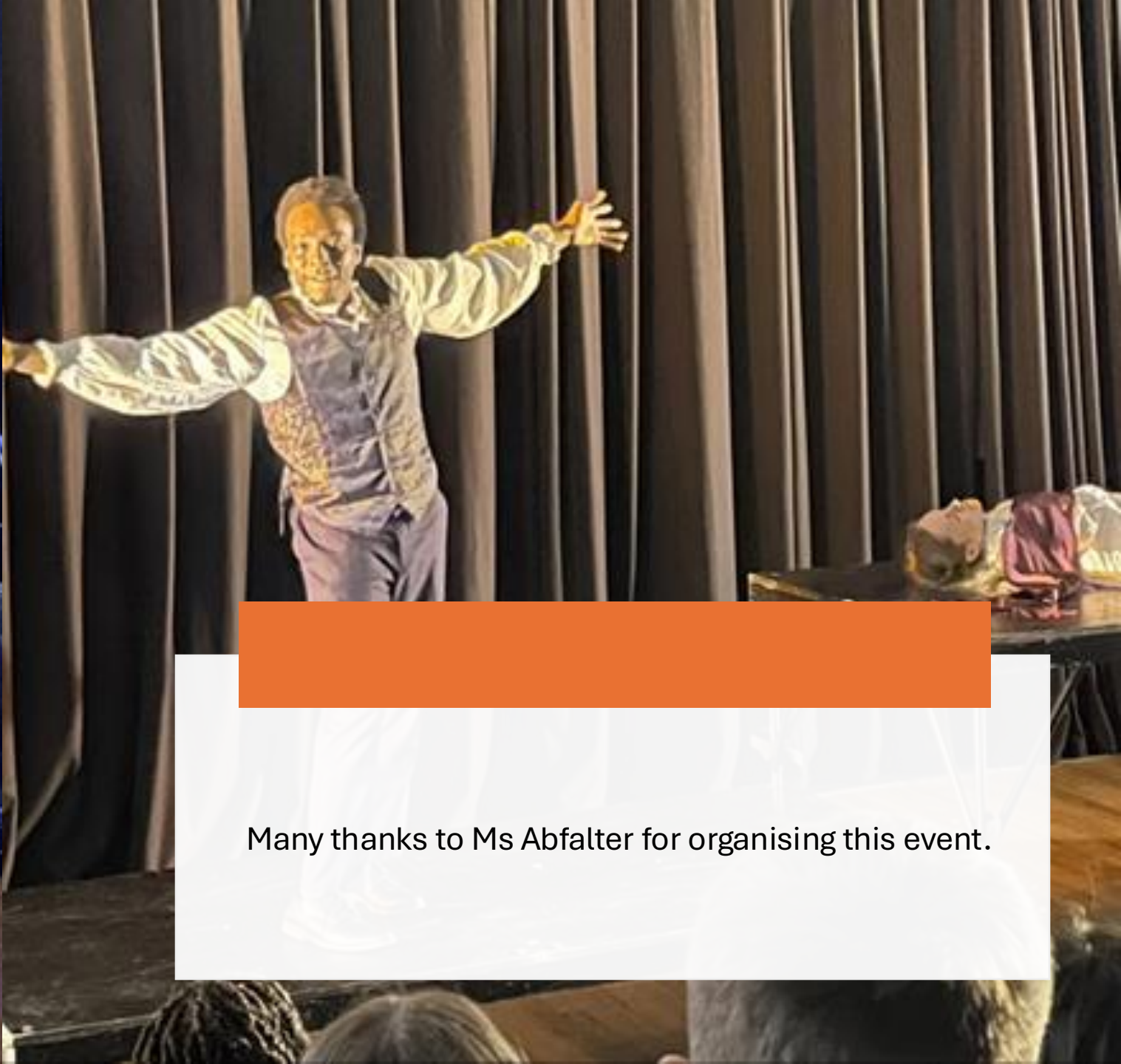

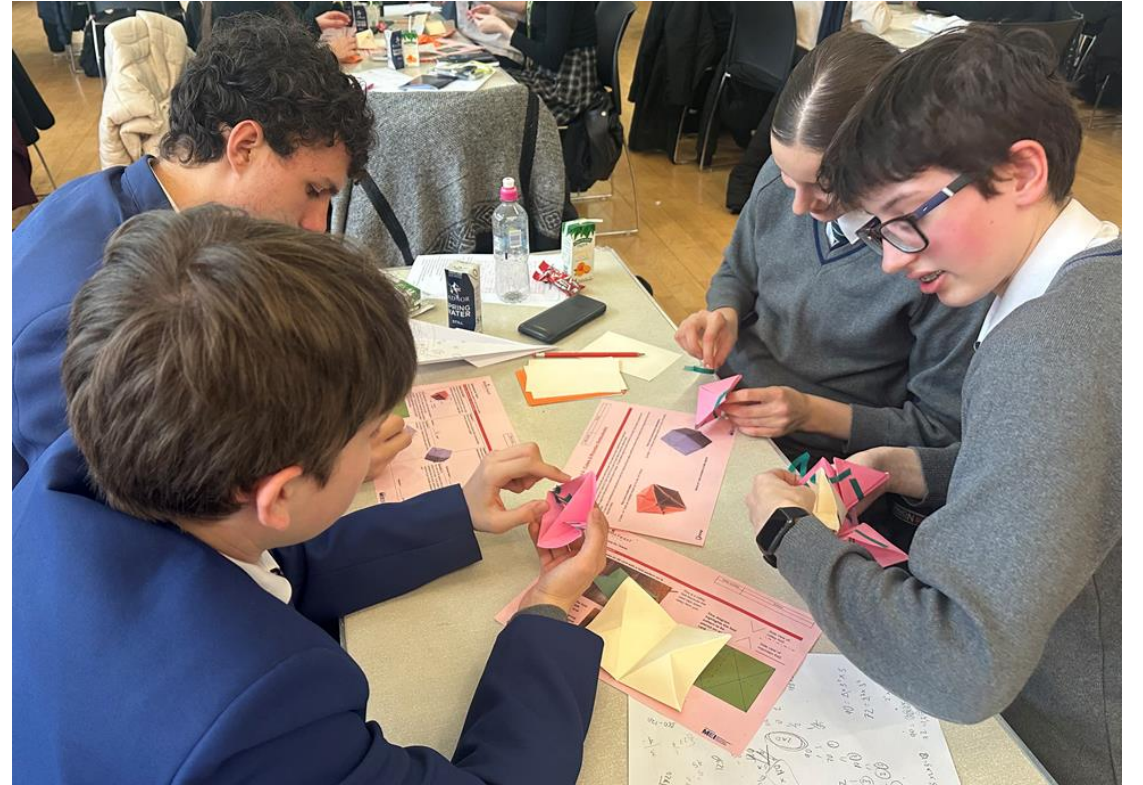
Year 10 Maths Feast Challenge

With many thanks to all of our visitors who gave of their time and expertise. The feedback from the students was very positive.



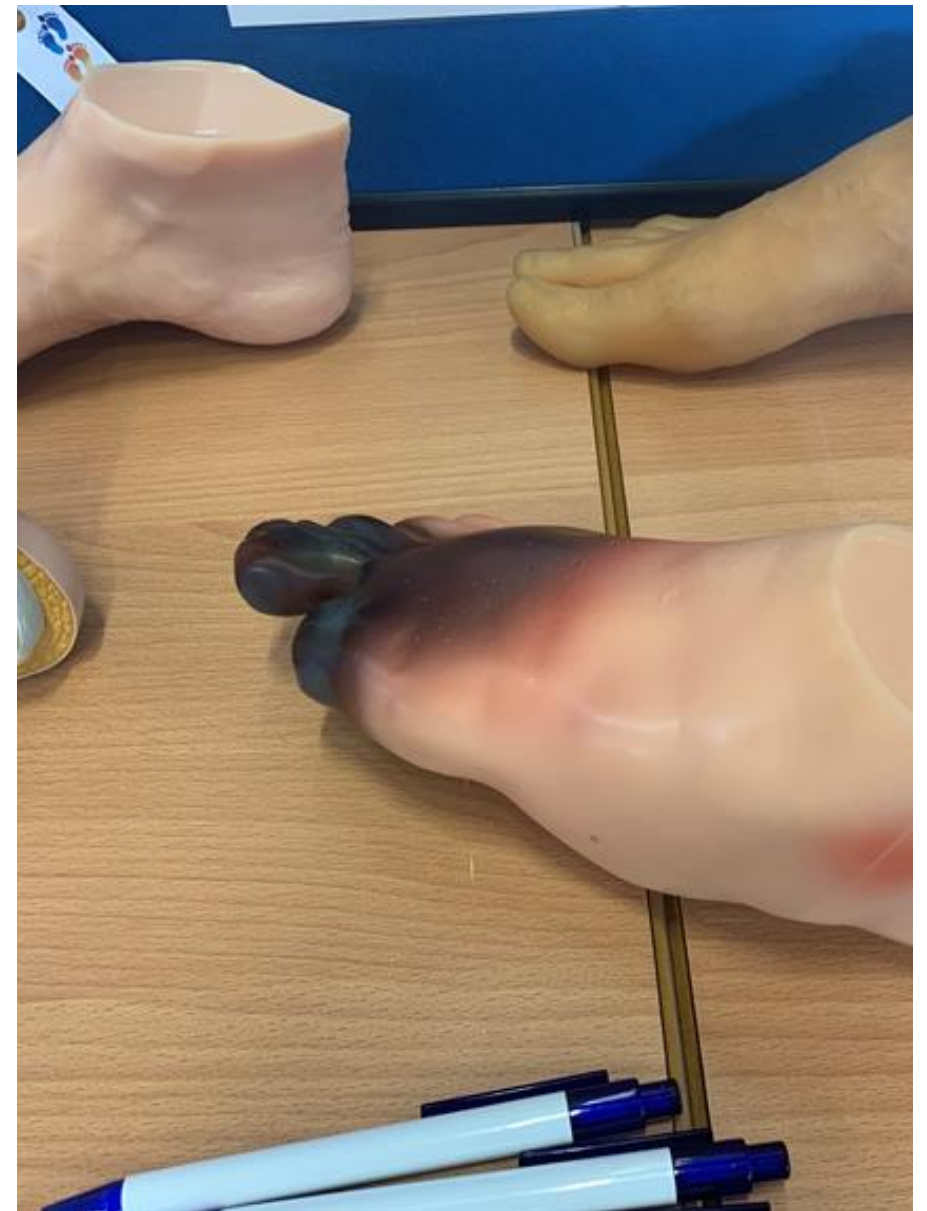
