# Code of Conduct

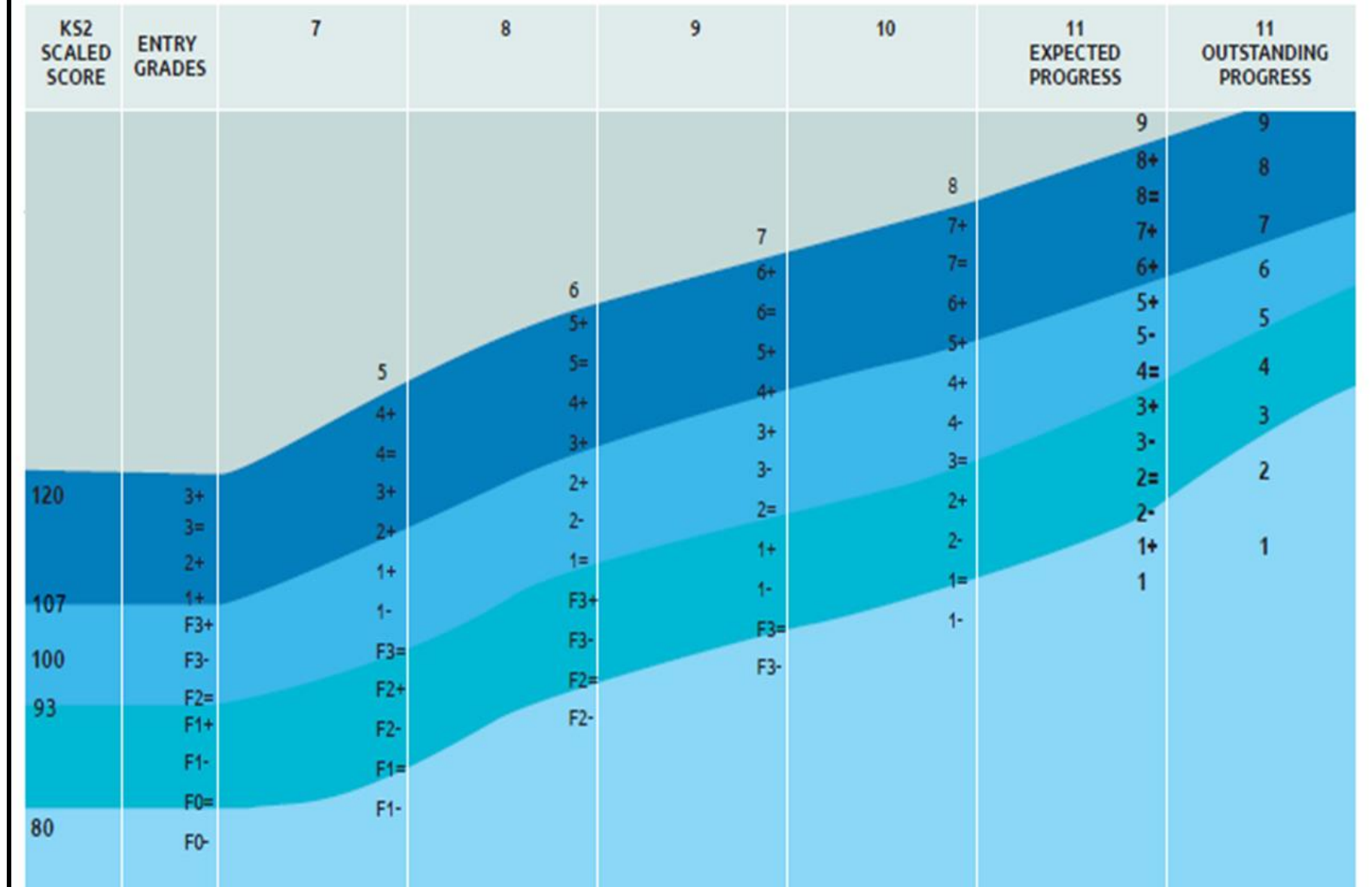
- Involvement with drugs (possession, handling, concealing, using or dealing) will result in permanent exclusion from the school.
- Involvement with offensive weapons (any items made or adapted, for causing or intending to cause physical or psychological harm) will result in permanent exclusion from the school.
- Persistent lack of co-operation, extreme acts of violence, serious incidents of theft, assaults or serious/persistent cases of bullying or serious incidents of child on child sexual abuse or harmful sexual behaviour will result in permanent exclusion from the school.

In line with DfE and OFSTED guidance the school has a zero tolerance approach to child on child sexual abuse





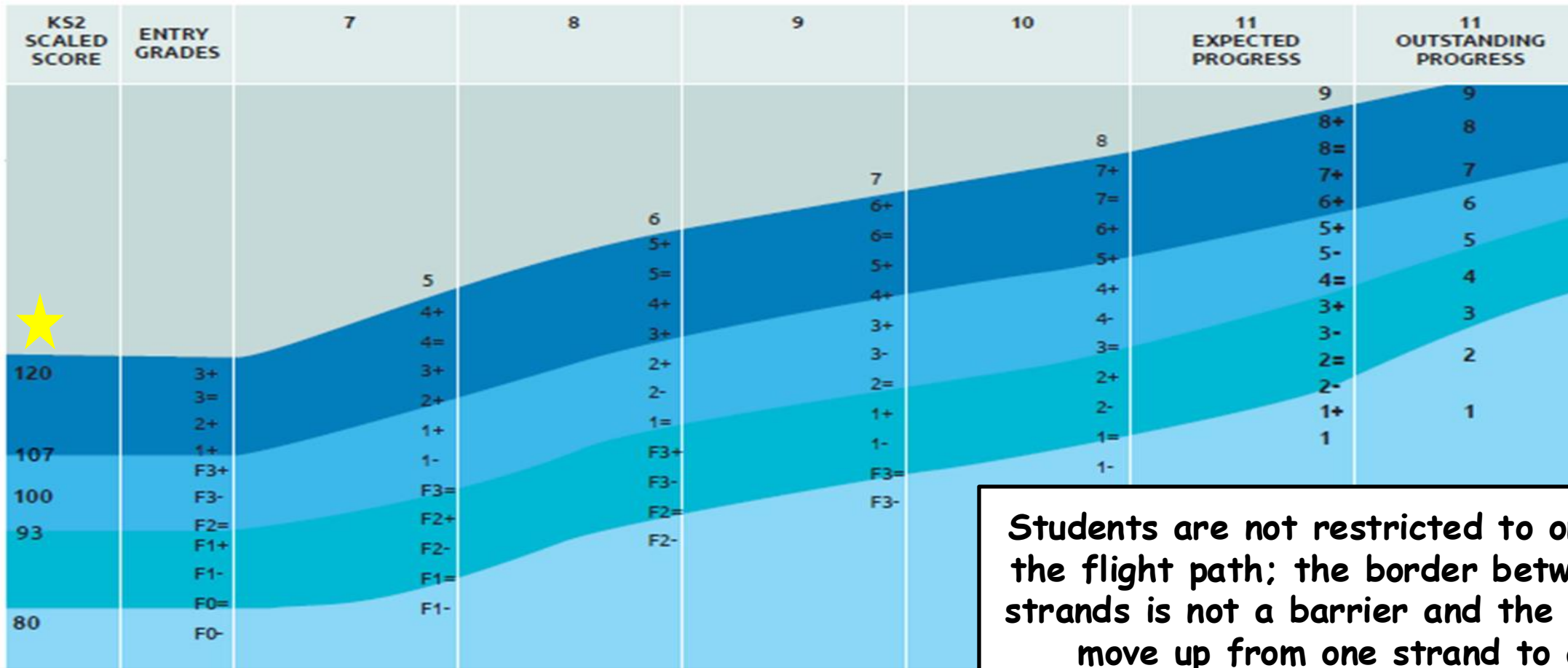
# KS3 and KS4 Flight Path: Expected and Outstanding Progress at Cardinal Wiseman

# KS3 and KS4 Flight Path: Expected and Outstanding Progress at Cardinal Wiseman



Students are not restricted to one strand of the flight path; the border between any two strands is not a barrier and the students can move up from one strand to another.

- Each strand of the flight path shows what the student can achieve at the end of year 11, if the same level of progress is maintained.
- There are 3 assessment points in Year 7 - November, February and May/June.
- Grades awarded cover all prior learning - homework, classwork, assessments and exams.



**Students are set Homework as follows:**

Once a week            English, Maths, Science, RE and French or Spanish

Once a fortnight    History and Geography

Once a half term     Music, Art, Drama, ICT and PE

**KS3 students are expected to spend around 5 hours a week on their Homework and obviously at certain times of the year there will be additional tasks preparing for examinations.**

**In addition KS3 students are expected to independently read for at least 30 minutes every evening in addition to their homework.**
